Historically the playrooms were founded on the basis of schools, the first playroom in our country and in the world was found in 1934 on the basis of primary school № 1 at Zagorsk, Moscow area, by the forces of teaching-pedology laboratory staff of the Toy scientific-research Institute. Playroom can become the center of the whole playing activity of junior pupils, including not only the board games but also inventory for agile games which can be the basis for school playroom: simple slit-up (folding) games (puzzles), brain-twister and conundrum (pictures and descriptions are attached).
